

The drug contained in cigarettes is called **nicotine**. This is what makes people become **addicted** to smoking.

As well as being an ingredient of cigarettes, nicotine is used as a **pesticide** to kill insects. The smoke from cigarettes contains carbon **monoxide** which is the same gas that comes out of car **exhaust** pipes. It causes there to be **less oxygen** in the blood which puts **pressure** on the **heart** which has to beat **faster**.

Cigarettes also contain <u>tar</u> and more than 4000 <u>poisonous chemicals</u> which cause illnesses and <u>diseases</u> such as <u>cancer</u>, emphysema, and bronchitis. Smoking cigarettes can <u>stain</u> the teeth and cause the smoker's breath, clothes and hair to <u>smell</u>. Smoking during <u>pregnancy</u> can also harm the baby.
