- ▶ Tasmania's inclusion in the 2027 draft is negatively impactful for clubs who finish lower on the ladder, with a compounding effect the lower you finish, creating material inequity for Clubs who finish lower on the ladder – especially from a Draft Value Index (DVI) perspective.
 - A Club who finishes 18th in 2027 will lose 932 points across the draft, the equivalent of Pick 16-17.
 - A Club who finishes 1st in 2027 will lose 443 points across the draft, the equivalent of Pick 31-32.
 - Every Club from 12th to 18th, from a points perspective in 2027, are losing the equivalent of pick 29 on their first-round pick, whereas the premier is losing the equivalent of pick 41-42 on their first-round pick.
 - A Club finishing 10th in 2027 can't match a bid on what would have been their natural pick (Pick 9, 1377 DVI) using their two first natural picks in 2027 (Picks 16 & 35, 1325 DV) under the capped 2-pick rule.
- ▶ Not only does a Club who finishes 18th in 2027 now have the risk of having a bid placed on one of their Academy/Father-Son/NGA prospects ahead of their first pick, but they will be forced into paying even greater DVI value if they were to match the bid.
 - A Club who finishes 18th in 2027, matching a bid from Tasmania at #1, would require 2700 draft points to match (after the 10% discount); but as they've lost 512 points from their first pick being moved down, they are essentially paying 3212 points (approx. Picks 5 & 6).
